Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to all Year 5 parents/carers because we know the transition from Primary to Secondary is a big step for you and your child. Induction activities can help prepare for this new milestone and together we can make sure the transition is less daunting.

It probably doesn't seem such a long time ago since you dropped your son/daughter off for their first day at school and now you are preparing for their move to high school and a whole new set of skills to master, from negotiating a timetable to meeting many new people.
