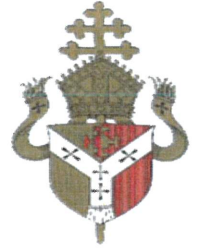

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your children had a fantastic half term. This letter is to inform you of some recent updates in school.

PE Policy update

During the first half term, it was decided by the directors of the collegiate that all schools within the collegiate will return to wearing school uniform on PE days. Therefore, children will be required to bring in a clean PE kit each week from today onwards. We ask that after each PE day, your child's kit is taken home to be washed and brought back to school in time for the next week's PE lesson. It is important that all children have the correct PE kit in school on their PE day each week. Teachers will remind the children when their PE day/s are for this half term. The day/s should stay the same throughout the half term. If for any reason this day needs to change, parents will be informed. Should your child attend an afterschool sports club and need to wear their PE kit, please ensure the kit is returned to school in time for their next PE lesson.

Relaxing Restrictions

Following advice from Public Health England and the directors of the collegiate, we will be reducing the restrictions in school back to what they were prior to the final week of the last half term. Therefore, school assemblies in the hall and attendance at Church will resume this week. KS1 and some KS2 children, who have hot dinners, will eat in the dining hall again. Staff will no longer be asked to wear face coverings in communal areas and when on the classroom door at the start and end of the day. Parents will not be asked to wear face coverings when inside the school grounds.

It is important to note, should this advice change or we feel it is necessary, some or all of these restrictions may be reintroduced. Parents will be made aware of this via a letter should this happen.
