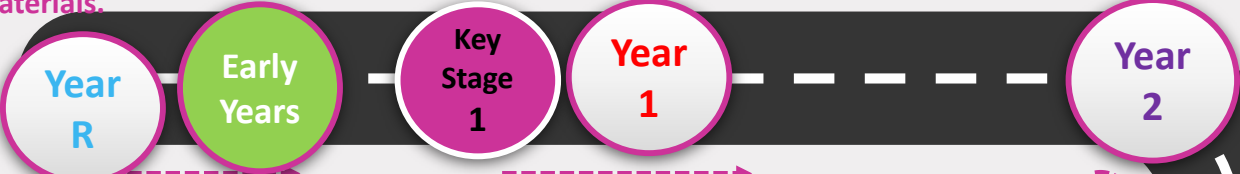
Early years

Can I work in the style of David Hockney?



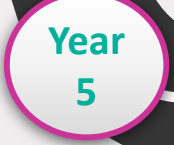
Art Knowledge
