

What is the Sacrament of Confirmation?

Confirmation is one of the seven sacraments of the Church.

Through receiving gifts of the Holy Spirit, it is hoped that children will, through their thoughts, words and actions, bear the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit: love, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, self-control and joy.

The candidate is showing their commitment to becoming a full member of the church.

Preparations

Children learn in detail about the Sacrament of Confirmation throughout their RE learning, workshops and discussion time.

Role of the Parent

- Parents are a child's first educators. It is the duty of parents, who are bringing their child up in the Catholic faith, to support them in their journey.
- At Confirmation, children are showing their own commitment to becoming a full member of the Catholic Church and need help to continue this after receiving the Sacrament.
- Parents are seen as role-models in this and should seek ways to ensure that children are given the opportunity to attend Mass regularly at the weekend and at other special times throughout the year.

Confirmation Names

Children should now have a chosen Saint name after spending a period of time researching and reflecting. It should be someone they admire and would aspire to be like and someone to whom they can offer their prayers of intercession.

Choosing a Saint's name is reaffirming the fact that the candidate is choosing and committing to becoming a full member of the Church.

Role of the chosen Sponsor

- Each child will need to choose a sponsor. A sponsor must be a baptised Catholic over the age of 14. Parents cannot be sponsors for their own children.
- It is usual that sponsors seek an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before the day of, or close to the day of, the Confirmation Mass. There will be an opportunity for this after our Whole School Mass on Thursday 14th March, starting at 9.30am.
- When the candidate goes forward to be confirmed, their sponsor will go with them. As the candidate kneels before Canon Paul, the sponsor stands behind them with their right hand placed on their right shoulder.
- The sponsor is present to provide spiritual support to the candidate.

- Each candidate will be invited to the front where they will kneel before Canon Paul. The sponsor will join them. They will be addressed by their chosen Saint's name and will be anointed with the oil of chrism. "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."
