We are very excited to be celebrating British Science Week again this year. This year the theme is 'Time'. This year British Science Week 2024 marks the Week's 30th anniversary, with the inaugural celebration happening in 1994.

They could create a poster showing how a certain type of technology has changed over time, or even the advancement of time-telling technology itself. Budding poster makers could also go futuristic, showing us how they think the world might look in years to come, or perhaps look at nature – lifecycles, lifespans, evolution and hibernation – nature is full of timely topics!
