## Stanley Head Outdoor Education Centre

A trip has been organised for our current Year 5 children, to visit Stanley Head Outdoor Education Centre, commencing **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025**. Pupils will have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of activities that the centre has to offer. The cost of the trip will be £283.00 per child, including transport, with accommodation being in separate boys and girls dormitories.

So that we can confirm numbers, a deposit of £33.00 should be paid to reserve a place for your child by the end of May 2024. The balance should be paid in 10 monthly instalments of £25.00, on the 23rd of each month, from June 2024. Payments and consent should be made on your child's scopay account. The full balance for the residential visit must be received no later than 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

Should you wish to discuss the cost and seek support with funding the trip, we encourage parents to contact the school at your earliest convenience and discuss with Mr Glover or Mrs Stonier. We appreciate the cost of this trip is great and will do what we can to ensure that the cost does not serve as a barrier to attendance.

We do hope you will encourage your child to participate. It is an invaluable opportunity for children to be involved in outdoor pursuits whilst promoting their independent skills. The learning that takes place during the week is based on the National Curriculum and so it is vital the pupils experience this.
