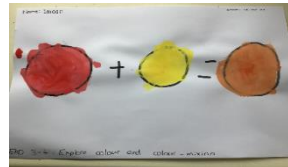

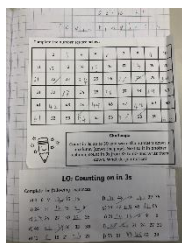

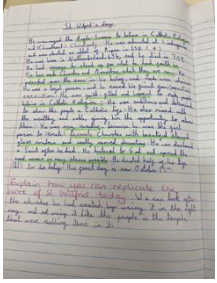

In particular this week, she has written a beautiful and informative piece about our school saint-St Wilfrid. She understands how we can carry on the work of St Wilfrid in our own special way.

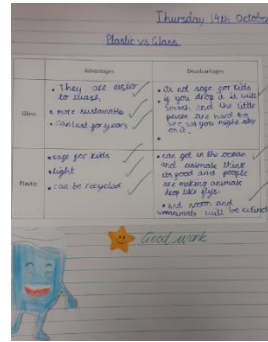
